4. Discussion Items
 - a. Walk-through of Gym & Locker Rooms
 - i. Close-out documents: one hard copy and digital copy.
 - ii. Crack in the new wood floor infill in the gym.
 - iii. Faucet levers need to be adjusted at the boys' locker room lavatories. They barely turn off when pressed tight up to the back of the sink.
 - iv. Lighting occupancy/vacant sensors appear to be different than the last addition. Their operation needs to be communicated to the School.
 - v. Tamper covers at the thermostats in the locker rooms.
 - vi. Provide spray foam insulation where wood trim has been removed at window infills in the locker rooms.
 - vii. Provide 2x4 blocking infill behind lockers at the window infills so there is not a gap where objects can fall behind lockers.
 - viii. Verify if existing plumbing drain/vents have been properly disconnected so sewer gas is not entering the locker rooms.
 - ix. Walls were not painted behind lockers. The School would like to have new CMU walls primed (block filler) where they will be covered by lockers. Existing painted walls do not need to be re-painted.
 - x. Remove plastic that was placed over WiFi router in girls' locker room.
 - xi. Platforms at RTUs are not complete.
 - xii. Hood ad DOAS not complete.
 - xiii. Fill glycol tank.
 - xiv. Make-up water is now obsolete. Provide signage to indicate such. Future project to disconnect and remove system.
